PROVISOS:

(U)1. The Department of State has reviewed your request for Prior Approval pursuant to 22 CFR 129.6 for brokering activities, related to the sale of USML Category I, II, III, VIII, X, and XII items as annotated in this application to the NATO Command, and NATO Support and Procurement Agency. A list of all the authorized parties are identified in the supporting documentation.

(U) 2. The Department of State approves your request subject to the following provisos and limitations:

(U) a. Data for release in accordance with this brokering agreement MUST be limited to data which is found in the Public Domain.

(U) b. The applicant MUST inform the licensee that the final hardware configuration will be subject to U.S. Government (USG) approval. Authorization for brokering does not constitute USG approval for the hardware described in the brokering agreement.

(U) c. Sales of mortar shells with M734A1 Multi-Option Fuze for Mortar MUST be by FMS.

(U) d. The applicant MUST NOT represent that the USG or U.S. Army is endorsing the sale of these weapons through this agreement.

(U) 3. This brokering approval IS NOT AN AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT any defense articles, defense services or technical data as designated in 22 CFR Part 121, which requires separate approval if applicable.

(U) 4. This determination does not imply that the transaction will be approved at the time of application. Your export request will be considered in light of U.S. foreign policy and national security concerns when your request is submitted.
